

Information on the processing of personal data

For Information Systems: IS registry administration

Information on the processing of personal data of the persons concerned pursuant to Article § 19 and § 20 of Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on Personal Data Protection and on the amendment of certain other Acts, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and to the Art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EC) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation")

The purpose of this information note is to provide you with information about what personal data we process, how we handle it, for which purposes we use it, to whom we can provide it, where you can obtain information about your personal data, and exercise your rights in the processing of such personal data.

1. Purpose of processing of personal data and legal basis of processing

The purpose of processing of personal data is: management of the registry and communication of the Controller with the public authorities

Personal data is processed pursuant to the Act no. 395/2002 Coll. on Archives and Registries and on the Amendments of Certain Acts, and pursuant to Act no. 305/2013 as amended.

Legitimate interests of the Controller or of the third party

The processing of personal data for the legitimate interests of the Controller or of the third party is not exercised.

2. Identification of the processed personal data of the persons concerned

Processed data of the persons concerned are: senders and recipients of correspondence

Scope of the processed personal data: title, first name, surname, signature, address, e-mail address, telephone number, scope of communication pursuant to Act no. 305/2013 Coll.

3. Identification of the recipients, categories of recipients

The Controller may provide personal data to the authorized entities such as institutions and organizations, authorized by a specific legal regulation or contractor (especially a processor) who have undertaken to accept reasonable guarantees to maintain the protection of processed personal data as follows:

With the consent of the person concerned, or by his/her order, personal data may be provided to other recipients.

4. Transfer of personal data to a third country/an international organization

Transfer to third countries, or to international organizations, is not carried out.

5. Personal data in the scope of Identification of the source from which personal data was collected

Directly from the person concerned or his/her legal representative

6. Period of the storage of personal data

The Controller shall process personal data for the period necessary to meet the purpose or for the duration of the contract.

7. Profiling

The Controller does not process personal data by profiling or similar analysis based on automated individual decision making.

8. Rights of the person concerned

The person concerned has the right to request from the Controller access to the data processed, the right to rectification of erroneous personal data, the right of erasure or restriction of processing of personal data, right to object to the processing of personal data, the right to inaction of automated individual decision-making, including profiling, the right to the portability of personal data, as well as the right to file a complaint for the opening of proceedings with the supervisory authority. In the case when the Controller processes personal data with the consent of the person concerned, the person concerned has the right at any time to withdraw his/her consent to the processing of personal data. Withdrawal of the consent does not affect the legality of the processing of personal data based on consent prior to its withdrawal. The person concerned can exercise his/her rights by sending an email to hs@hs.sk or in writing to the address of the Controller.

9. Obligation to provide personal data

Provision of personal data is a legal requirement, and processing of personal data is mandatory. The person concerned has an obligation to provide personal data, and if a person will not provide such data, he/she violates the law.
